Believe it or not, but legendary blues guitarist Johnny McCook is still alive and going strong on the stage. A crowd of 400 was blown away by his performance at the Jukebox last night, where he belted out a stunning show that lasted over two and half hours. The set was heavy with his classic tunes, most dating from the bumpin' era of the 60's and 70's Chicago blues-rock scene. However, McCook surprised the crowd with a few unexpected covers, including a heart-wrenching rendition of "Baby got back", as well as an unplugged version of Twisted Sister's "We're not gonna take it." Finally, McCook wrapped up the night with a double encore of his two most famous hits, "Fall Blues" and "Alleycat." During the latter, he got up from his chair, where he normally stays seated for the duration of his performances, and stood on one of the speakers to deliver an inspiring solo. It was the finishing touch on an epic performance.

This was the fourth time I have seen Johnny McCook play in the last 20 years, and I might even argue that it was the best. He seems to have lost none of the energy or vitality of his youth. McCook's voice finds its way into your soul, and his guitar licks get into your skin and stays there. In my opinion, McCook's performance at the Jukebox last night not only proved that he still has it, but in doing so, it also secured his position into the rock 'n' roll hall of fame.
